FSU Instructor Credentials Certification Form

This form must be used to certify instructor credentials to teach specific courses when:

- 1. Assigning any Post-doc or Adjunct (including staff members teaching either within their position descriptions or on overloads), as Instructor of Record for the first time to a course. A new form is required only when an Adjunct is assigned to teach in an academic area different from one in which they have been certified.
- 2. Assigning any full-time faculty member as Instructor of Record for the first time to teach a specific course that falls outside the academic area in which they hold a terminal degree (e.g., a faculty member with a Math Ph.D. is assigned to teach a Statisticscourse).
