The solar lights are designed by the Berlin artist Olafur Eliasson for **Little Sun**, an organization that envisions universal access to clean energy and reducing climate injustices. Little Sun organizes and helps develop events by artists as part of their online **STORIES**, where this film will be shared and archived.

Little Sun solar lights will be included in **HURRICANE GO-PACKS**, which will provide the Tallahassee community with access to clean water and assistance during hurricane preparation. The Hurricane Go-Pack consists of a backpack, a portable water bottle filter system that provides up to 100,000 gallons of clean water, a tarp with labeling that can be seen from the sky, a bandana with printed evacuation routes to shelters to assist in staying safe, as well as the Little Sun solar light. Kits will be placed in public libraries then loaned out during hurricane season for disaster relief and to help reduce consumption from single-use plastic water bottles.
