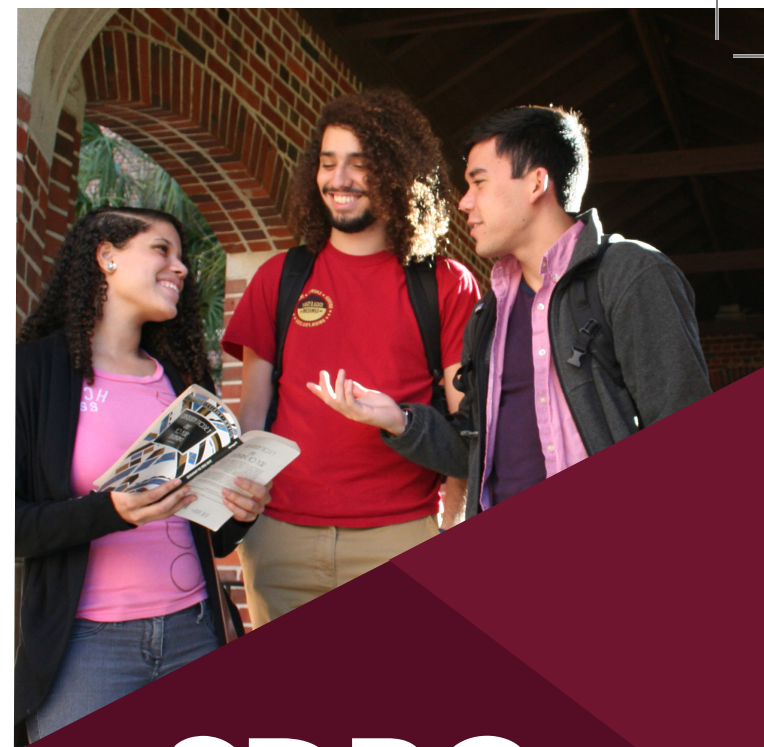

As a resource on campus for students with disabilities, the SDRC works with faculty and staff to provide accommodations for the unique needs of students both in and out of the classroom.

Confidentiality

Student names and the nature of disabilities are kept confidential and used solely for the purpose of providing accommodations.

How to Register for Services

Students who choose to disclose their disability to receive accommodations must provide documentation and make an appointment to register for services. Guidelines for documentation are on SDRC website. Staff members will determine reasonable accommodations.

Note: Students must be admitted to the University to register for services. Contact the SDRC office for more information.

FSU Accessible Van

The SDRC van provides on-campus transportation for students, faculty and staff with mobility impairments.
