Short Title: A Bill Allocating \$300 to Counseling and School Psychology Students Helping to Advocate, Organize, and Serve.

Summary of Legislation:

The bill allocates \$300 from COGS Reserves to Counseling and School Psychology Students Helping to Advocate, Organize, and Serve for their Faculty and Student Social on November 16, 2025.

Background Information:

CHAOS is the RSO for the students in the Combined Doctoral Program in Counseling Psychology and School Psychology in the College of Education, Health, and Human Sciences. CHAOS seeks to advocate, organize, and serve on behalf of their field.

Their Faculty and Student Social will take place on November 16, 2025, from 5 P.M. to 8 P.M. off campus. An off-campus waiver resolution is filed and attached as Attachment #2. This social event will help foster the relationships between faculty and new/returning students. With proper relationships formed, current students will have an increase in motivation in their studies and receive more tailored support from their faculty, improving outcomes for the students in the program. Prospective students could potentially benefit from meeting the faculty of the program as they apply for next year's cohort as well. The funding will be for catering from Moe's Southwestern Grill to bolster likely attendance.

CHAOS previously received funds from Speaker's Request in August and has leftover funds. Therefore, CHAOS only needs \$300 to have the budget for the event.

Summary of Legislation:

The bill allocates \$750.00 from COGS Reserves to support the Live Well: Graduate Student Edition – Mind, Body, Soul Lunch & Learn series co-sponsored by CHAW and COGS.

Background Information:

The Live Well: Graduate Student Edition – Mind, Body, Soul series is a three-part Lunch & Learn event designed to promote holistic wellness among graduate students. Co-sponsored by the Center for Health Advocacy and Wellness (CHAW) and the Congress of Graduate Students (COGS), the series will address mental, physical, and emotional well-being through themed sessions titled: *Mind: Finding Calm in the Chaos, Body: Fuel, Rest, and Reset*, and *Soul: Centering Yourself Through Connection and Care*.

Each session will take place from 12:00 PM - 1:00 PM in HWC 2500:
