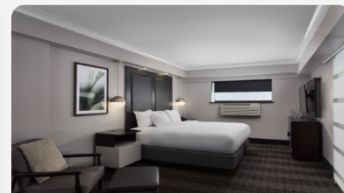

# 34<sup>th</sup> Congress of Graduate Students Legislation Cover Sheet

**COGS Bill #: 13**

**Sponsor(s):** Representative Peters

**Short Title:** MPHSA Budget Transfer Request

**Summary of Legislation:** This legislation will reallocate funds from the Clothing/Awards category to the General Expenses category within the MPHSA's current budget. This will help cover the remaining \$145.25 cost for their upcoming Graduate Public Health Conference on April 11, 2026, and their remaining events in the Spring 26 semester.

**Background Information:** The MPHSA, or better known as the Master of Public Health Student Association, has requested a budget transfer of \$700 from the Clothing/Awards category to the General Expense category. This transfer was triggered due to unanticipated costs associated with their Annual Public Health Professions Conference, which will be held in the Student Services Building (SSB) in Rooms 201/203 and 208/219 on April 11, 2026. MPHSA is hosting this event, and the proposed transfer will cover the \$145.25 conference venue shortfall from their initial budget request, which is presently being facilitated via an expedited Speaker Request. The additional funds, that being the remaining \$554.75, are needed for other costs at the conference on April 11th and the MPH Graduate Hooding Ceremony on May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Effect of Proposed Legislation:** This proposed bill would effectively fund the Public Health Professions Conference and remaining MPHSA events for the Spring 2026 semester. Events such as these are fundamental for MPH graduate students because they empower students from health and related fields by fostering unity, knowledge, and access to resources, and propelling them towards successful careers in public health. The primary goals of this conference and other events hosted by MPHSA are to share knowledge, provide career opportunities, and foster networking connections for all students. Furthermore, this conference is free for students to attend, which is rare for professional conferences that typically cost hundreds of dollars. Through the speaker seminar sessions, the networking hour, the tabling portion, and our inaugural student research showcase, this Conference will provide free resources and opportunities for students to gain exposure, enhance their professionalism, and build connections.

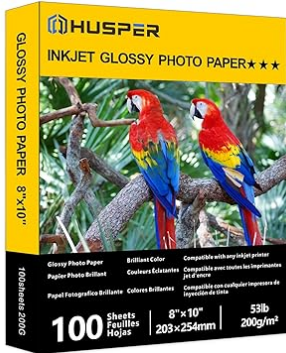
