
The Mary Kay Foundation is a non-profit public foundation, which focuses on funding research for innovative grants for translational research in ovarian, uterine, breast or cervical cancer. Translational research is broadly defined as research that will provide a scientific link between laboratory research and the clinic. Ultimately, such research would lead to improvement in diagnosis, prognosis, prevention, or treatment of the cancer. The Foundation is pleased to invite your institution to submit one grant proposal. **Please note: only one grant application will be accepted from each accredited invited institution.**

Your grant proposal will be reviewed by a Scientific Research Review Committee composed of notable members of the American medical and scientific community. It is our hope that you will identify and encourage the appropriate person within your institution to complete the application. The grant will be up to \$100,000 (combined direct and indirect costs) for a two-year period. If indirect costs are requested, they cannot exceed 15%. If selected, the funds will be paid in two payments. The first payment will be after receipt of the executed contract. The second payment will be mailed following receipt of the first-year status report. The Foundation anticipates funding between ten and fifteen grants.

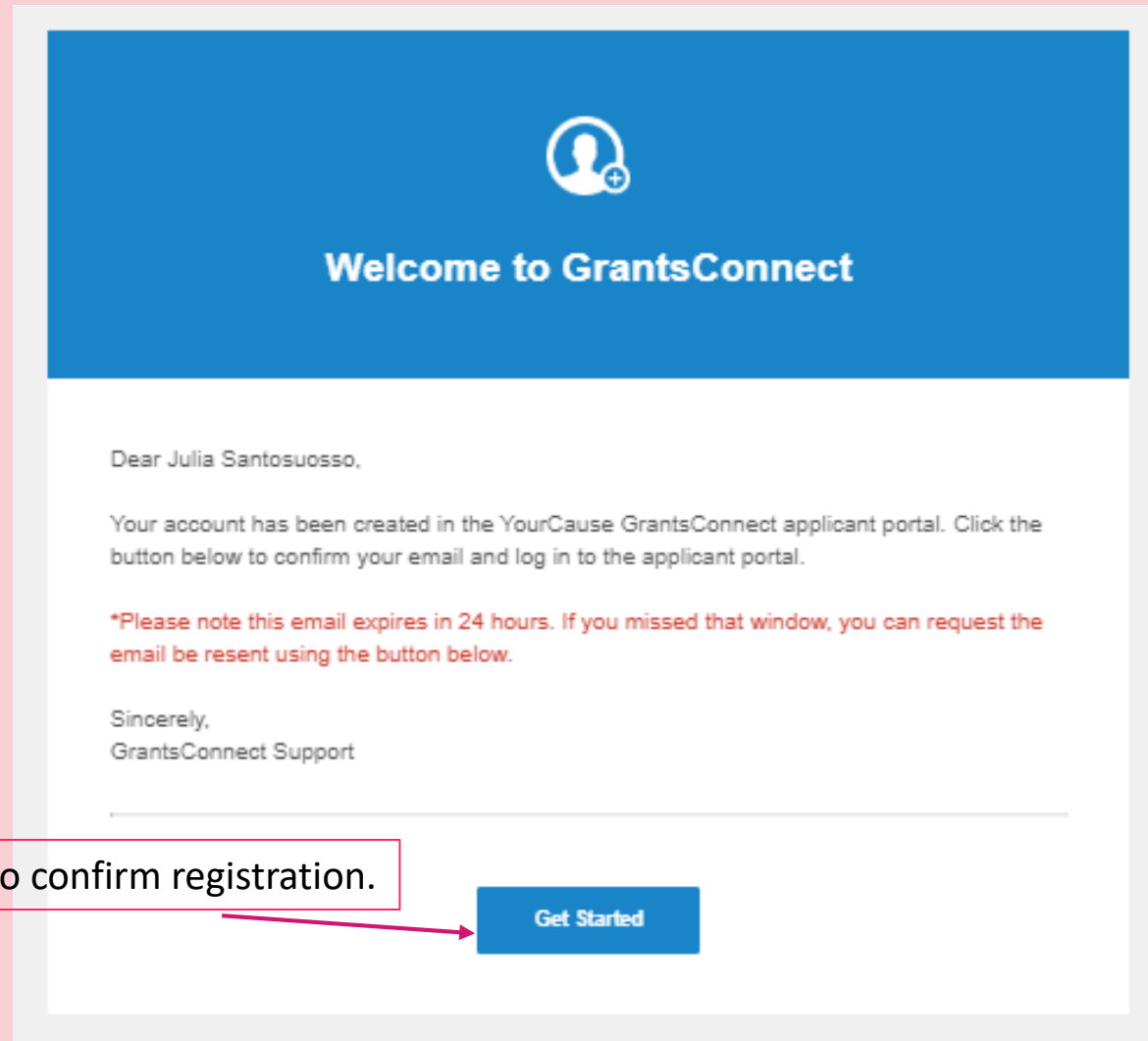



Search tips

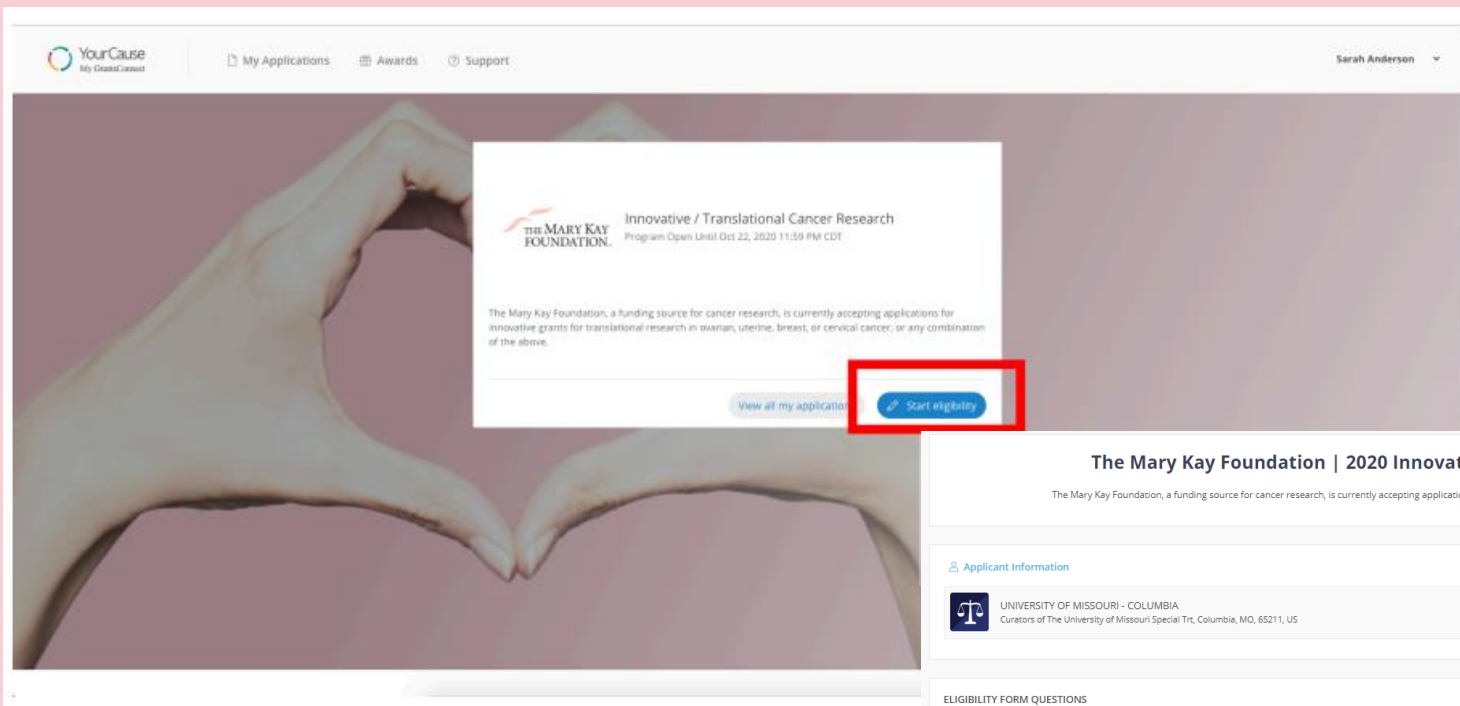
When searching for an organization, it's important to remember that we use information on file with the various government agencies that register charities around the world. That means the information we have may not exactly match how you refer to your organization.

- Search by Registration ID. This is the government issued id used to uniquely identify the charity.
- Check for abbreviations. For example, try searching for Co instead of County
- Check spelling and concatenations; For example, use "FoodBank" instead of "Food Bank"
- Don't use common words and punctuation. Remove words like a and the, as well as punctuation like periods, commas and dashes.
- Drop the suffixes. For example, use bird and not birds, walk and not walked.

If your organization is not listed:

- Click Need help? > Can't find your organization? > Add it here.
- You will need to provide your institution's EIN (identification number)

The program will offer grants up to \$100,000 each (combined indirect and direct costs). Indirect costs cannot exceed 15%. Funds may be used in a one-year period or up to two years. Applications must be submitted by one Principal Investigator, (Full-Time Assistant Professor or higher at the time of application submission) and must be selected by the Institution.

Only one grant application will be accepted from each invited cancer research institute or medical school. Grants are limited to the United States.

This grant opportunity will be submitted electronically. Please adhere to the following guidelines with regards to your digital scans and uploaded supporting documents for submission:

1. All documents should be PDF files, single-sided, 12-point type, in Times New Roman or similar font. Scans of all documents are acceptable.
2. Principal Investigator's name (last name, first name) should be included in the upper right-hand corner of each document.
3. Total budget for the entire project should not exceed \$100,000 (combined indirect and direct costs). Equipment and travel costs should be justified. Indirect costs, should not exceed 15%. List budget details in text field provided below.
4. List other current financial support, this should include all federal, private, or PHS 398, and "other support" from institutional sources of funding and % of effort on each project and potential overlap between other support and this proposal. (use of NIH forms or facsimile are acceptable)
5. Please do not send additional letters of support or materials not specifically requested.
6. Page ordering and length requirements
 - Description of the Research (5 pages maximum)
 - Start with specific aims, preliminary results and research design. Page total should include any illustrations and tables. Literature/References Cited (2 pages maximum)
 - Letters of Collaboration (3 pages maximum)
 - Current Financial Support (2 pages maximum)
 - NIH Biosketch or equivalent (5 pages maximum)
 - a. Provide a biographical sketch or PHS 398 Biographical Sketch form for professional personnel listed on budget request. Please submit only the enclosed form or the PHS 398 Biographical Sketch. U.S. citizenship is not required.
