



Catalina Island Marine Institute Marine Science Instructors Wanted!

The Catalina Island Marine Institute (CIMI) is hiring Marine Science Instructors for two of its sites: Toyon Bay and Fox Landing. Instructors lead groups of up to 16 students through 3- or 5-day overnight field trips, which involve taking students snorkeling, kayaking, hiking, and teaching them about marine science and island ecology. CIMI operates a fall and a spring season serving students in grades 4-12, with opportunities for instructors to stay on and work for the summer camp programs as well. New staff are asked to make an initial commitment of two school-year seasons.

Required:

- Bachelor's degree in a science field
- Ability to pass an American Red Cross Waterfront Lifeguarding Course (provided by CIMI)
- Desire to work with children
- Good character, integrity, flexibility and adaptability

Preferred:

- College courses or degree in marine science
- Water experience
- Teaching experience
