# ISL Planning Grant

- **Important Deadlines to keep in mind:**
  - **Application Deadline: March 21, 2022, 11:59 p.m.**
  - **Award notification: May 1st, 2022**
  - **Award Period: May 14, 2022 – May 15, 2023**
- ISL is looking at potentially increasing the dollar award amount of our ISL Planning Grants. Currently, our budget allows for 6 grants total at \$15,500 but we are thinking of increasing the amount to \$25,000 and that amount would let us award 3 grants.

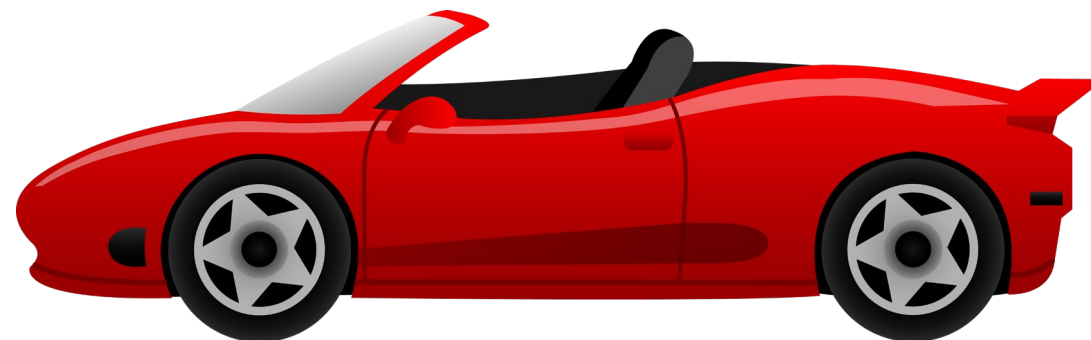






# RCN-NSF Transportation Day Update
