Pat Capps Covey College of Allied Health Professions Policy for initiating clinical practicum post COVID-19

Programs in the Pat Capps Covey College of Allied Health Professions are required to provide a policy for initiating clinical practicum post COVID-19. The key required components are outlined below.

Programs must verify that clinical affiliates:

- 1. will not allow students to interact with COVID patients or Patients Suspected of COVID.
- 2. Will not allow students to take care of patients under airborne precautions or patients undergoing aerosolization procedures whose COVID status is unknown
- 3. Will not allow students to take care of patients whose care requires donning of an N-95 mask
- 4. are in compliance with current Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidance
- 5. are in compliance with current relevant Public Health Agency
- 6. are in compliance with professional standards (e.g. certifying body, licensing agency, accrediting body etc...)
- 7. are in compliance with State Governor's orders
- 8. screens patients and employees for COVID-19 per above agencies
- 9. requires appropriate PPE

The Program will

- 1. Train students regarding:
 - a. COVID-19
 - b. Hand hygiene
 - c. Infection control
 - d. PPE Use
 - e. What to do if exposed to an individual with COVID-19
- 2. Provide guidance on attire as well as how to sanitize clothing and shoes.
- 3. Require appropriate PPE, minimally a cloth mask. Provide direction on how to sanitize cloth masks.
- 4. Provide clear direction that the student may discontinue clinical training at any time and that we will work with them to secure future training when they are ready.
- 5. Require self-monitoring of symptoms (i.e. temperature monitoring before clinical timeslot begins, cough, shortness of breath, fever, myalgia, loss of smell, loss of taste, unusual headache, diarrhea).
- 6. Provide clear direction to NOT go to clinical placements if they suspect any symptoms as well as who to report this to.
- 7. Provide clear direction on how to get testing for COVID-19 if symptoms present or if exposed
- 8. Require self-quarantine for a 14-day period if exposed to COVID-19
- 9. Require students to maintain a safe lifestyle (e.g. practice social distancing and safe practices for outings)
- 10. Require students to abide by the USA travel policy for COVID-19
